## Minutes of the meeting to consider applications for import of 5 Lakh MT of raw sugar duty free under TRQ

The Exim Facilitation Committee(EFC) chaired by Addl. DGFT Sh. K.C. Rout met on 26.4.2017 to decide on the allocation of quota on applications received under the Notification No.1& 2 dated 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 and 13<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 for import of 5 lakh MT of raw sugar duty free under Exim Code 17014 of Chapter 17 of ITC (HS) 2017. The List participants are at **Annex-I**.

2. The Committee noted that 50 applications have been received till the cutoff date i.e. 24<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 (5.00 p.m.). It was also noted that the Notification No. 1 dated 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 had indicated that the EFC, while considering applications, will look into factors, inter-alia, like Zonal allocation limit, monthly refining capacity of the applicant, the quantity applied for by the applicant and the total number of applications within a zone.

3. In light of the above, the applications were examined jointly by the officers of the Department of Food & Public Distribution and DGFT. The information furnished by the applicants were tabulated on the above criteria and placed before the Committee Members in the meeting.

4. The Committee in its meeting decided to abide by the criteria as notified and examined the applications on the following basis:

- I. The Zone wise applications are as under: East Zone-1 application, South Zone 40applications and the West Zone-9 –applications, making it a total of 50.
- II. The Committee considered the per day refining/ processing capacity of the applicants, as indicated in their self-declaration and cross verified it with the figures as in the IEM certificate/other supporting documents. The capacity of the applicant unit has been taken as per the quantity indicated in the self declaration or quantity mentioned in the documents, whichever was lower. The daily capacity has been arrived at by taking into account the given annual production capacity based on 270 working days for Tamilnadu and 180 working days for other states.
- III. The two months capacity of the applicant unit has been taken as the upper limit of allocation subject to quantity applied for since two months time period has been allowed for conversion of raw sugar to white/refined sugar as per the Notifications as above. The formula adopted for allocation of quota is: Zonal allocated quantity divided by total monthly capacity of all the applicant mills/units within the Zone multiplied by the refining capacity of the applicant unit.
- IV. Where ever, there are more than one application for the same processing unit in any zone, all these applications have been treated as one application for the purpose of allocation. However, in case an applicant unit has submitted more than one application in two or more zones for the same unit, such applications were treated separately, but the capacity for the purpose of allocation is taken by dividing the unit's capacity based on pro rata to the Zonal limit. The cases where there is one application for more than

one processing unit, the allocation was made taking into account all the units together but the license will show separate quantity for each unit.

V. KGS Sugar & Infra Corporation Ltd, Nasik has claimed to have sent an email indicating their desire to participate in the Scheme. However, no application has been received along with the mail. The applicant has also mentioned that they would be submitting documents after receiving allocation. It was confirmed that no attachment was received with their mail date 24<sup>th</sup> April 2017. Therefore, the committee was constrained to reject the case.

5. In light of the above, the Committee allocated the quota to each applicant as detailed in the **Annex-II.** 

6. Those applicants who do not want to avail themselves of the import quota of raw sugar allocated under this scheme may even now opt out by writing to their respective RA not to issue license before 5 pm of 28<sup>th</sup> April, 2017. Once license is issued and the applicant does not import raw sugar, the penalty provision will be applicable.

7. The Committee also decided to meet to consider reallocation of surrendered or cancelled quota to the eligible applicants after the deadline indicated in the notification.
